**Vsebina:**

- Analiziranje strukture avtentičnih strokovnih besedil v okviru pogojev besedilnosti in posebnosti znanstvenega jezika na nivoju stavka, odstavka.
- Prepoznavanje lastnosti znanstvene in strokovne literature (zgradba abstrakta, citiranje) in razvijanje sposobnosti pisanja povzetkov (abstraktov).
- Širjenje strokovnega besedišča in rabe jezika s slovničnimi in funkcionalnimi jezikovnimi strukturami, značilnih za znanstveno zvrst družboslovja z medpredmetno povezanimi nalogami.
- Pisanje esejev (600 besed) in daljših besedil o izbrani temi upoštevajoč IMRAD standarde v sodelovanju z učitelji strokovnih predmetov.
- Razvijanje sposobnosti samostojnega razumevanja govornega strokovnega besedila ter beleženja in povzemanja vsebine teh besedil.
- Oblikovanje in priprava na samostojni govorni nastop na strokovno temo upoštevajoč zakonitosti učinkovite strokovne predstavitve v angleškem jeziku.

**Content (Syllabus outline):**

- Professional Communication in English classes focus on developing the future academics' abilities to express themselves in spoken and written mode in academic context, as well as improving their language use and pronunciation.
- Practice in producing acceptable writing for academic purposes (IMRAD) is provided in terms of set coursework and monthly timed writing tasks in collaboration with subject teachers.
- Practice in becoming a competent reader of academic texts with vocabulary work (nouns, verbs, adverbs, phrases relevant to academic writing...) is provided through set reading and monthly timed reading tasks.
- A feedback on the students' writing and reading is provided during office hours or at students' request in collaboration with core subjects' teachers.
- Students are instructed on how to summarise their professional spoken texts.
- Throughout the course students are guided how to become a more effective and independent learners and users of online resources in preparation of their presentations.

Omogoča jim razvijanje kritične refleksije, socialnih in komunikacijskih zmožnosti v angleškem jeziku pri delu v interdisciplinarnih timih.

Student will be able to use English to deepen their professional knowledge by searching for information and data in cooperation with other courses. They will be able to recognise the language of academic writing and learn how to write professionally oriented essays and report on them. They will critically assess their social and communicative performance skills in interdisciplinary teams.
