Prof. dr. Nicolae Urs: E-government development in Romania.

A graduate of the College of Political, Administrative and Communication Sciences (FSPAC) in Cluj-Napoca, Nicolae Urs defended his PhD thesis in 2013, its topic being the changes brought by the Internet in the printed press. Starting with 2001, he has been teaching various courses that have to do with technology and its influence on society, at FSPAC, in the Departments of Public Administration and Management, Journalism, and Communication and PR. He is involved in multiple projects aimed at improving e-government, especially at local level, and he coordinated the e-government strategies for a number of urban communities in Romania. His research interests are e-governance, changes brought by technology, and visual display of statistical data. He is a vice-dean of FSPAC since 2014.

E-government development in Romania is linked to bigger trends in Central and Eastern Europe, but it has a number of particularities that make it a rich study topic. From the influence of the European Union, to underwhelming central coordination, to the role of big cities as trailblazers in implementing online services, and to the use of social media by political figures, the idiosyncrasies of Romania's electronic governance can be a source of both good and bad examples for the digitization of government institutions.
