CALL FOR TENDERS

Application procedure for student tutors

for the academic year 2026/2027

for the Master's degree program in Public Sector Governance, 2nd cycle

To apply, students of the Faculty of Public Administration must be enrolled in at least the second year of the second cycle of studies (or have completed the requirements for entry to the second year of the second cycle of studies in the academic year 2026/2027).

Applicants may apply for the following forms of tutoring:

1. Subject tutoring for the following areas or subjects: administrative law field (Administrative Procedural Law; Tax Procedural Law, etc.), Social Science Research Methods.

I. The student tutor will mainly perform the following tasks:

- tutoring;
- keeping records of tutoring work with students;
- compiling an annual report on his/her work;
- training according to the student tutor training program;
- attending organized faculty meetings;
- constant communication with tutors and the tutor teacher;
- monthly reporting as directed by the tutoring coordinators;
- promotion of tutoring;
- other tasks as required and agreed with the tutoring coordinators.

II. Conditions for applying

A candidate applying for a subject tutoring scheme must:

- be enrolled in at least the second year of studies at level 2 in the academic year 2026/2027 (or have completed the requirements for entry to the upper second cycle of studies in the academic year 2026/2027),
- have a minimum grade point average of 8 in their studies to date in this program,
- have a minimum grade of 8 in the administrative law field courses or Social Science Research Methods course.

Priority for selection is given to students with a higher average grade in the course to be tutored and a higher average grade point in their previous studies.

Desirable skills and competences for a student tutor for subject tutoring:

- knowledge of the material and the ability to provide additional support in understanding and mastering the subject matter of the area being tutored;
- knowledge of appropriate teaching methods and strategies for the subject being tutored;
- knowledge and familiarization of students with all the necessary sources of information and literature for the course being tutored;
- the ability to provide assistance in mastering the more difficult content of the tutor's course.

III. Number of places available and content of the application:

Number of places available for each form of tutoring:

1. Subject tutoring by subject area: 2 (1 for administrative law field, 1 for the subject Social Science Research Methods).

Note: The Faculty of Public Administration reserves the right to select fewer or more students than the number of places available, depending on the needs of the academic year.

When applying, applicants must specify which tutoring job they are applying for and submit:

- CV,
- a motivation letter (maximum 800 characters) explaining why they want to tutor.

IV. Evaluation of the work

Successful completion of the work of student tutors is valued at 3 ECTS credits per academic year, and the student tutor receives a certificate from the faculty stating that the tutoring work has been completed.

V. Submission of applications

Applications are accepted by email: crpo@fu.uni-lj.si.

Deadline for applications: **15 September 2026**. If there are still places available, applications can be submitted later until the places are filled.

Candidates will be notified of their selection by 1 October 2026, or later if the places are filled after 15 September 2026.

The Senate of the Faculty of Public Administration, expected to take place in September 2026, or at subsequent Senate meetings if there is a need to fill the positions after 15 September 2026, will appoint the selected candidates.

If the candidate does not have student status in the academic year 2026/2027 (starting 1 October 2026), the application for tutoring and the selection will become void.
