Metode poučevanja in učenja:

1. Študenti poleg obravnavanja literature raziskujejo pojavnne oblike, značilnosti, probleme računalniškega prava ter njegove uporabe v upravi.
2. V sklopu timskega dela se ukvarjajo s študijo primera in opravijo primerjalno analizo stanja različnih upravnih praks.
3. Z izdelavo projekta teoretsko in uporabno rešujejo konkretne probleme.
4. Debate pomagajo pri usposabljanju za ustno poslovno komuniciranje, jasnost in natančnost v izražanju ter analitičnost pri zbiranju podatkov, dejstev in utemeljitv. Debate o določeni temi s pripravo pisnih argumentov.
5. Delo v spletnih delavnicah, prek forumov in blogov.
6. Uporaba Moodle za aktiviranje študentov v elektronskem okolju.

Learning and teaching methods:

1. Students, in addition to the study of literature, research forms, characteristics, issues of computer law and its application in the administration.
2. In teams, they deal with the study (court) cases and conduct a comparative analysis of different administrative practices.
3. By project designing they theoretically and applicatively solve specific problems.
4. Debates are for training in oral communication, clarity and precision and analytical expression in collecting data, facts and arguments. Debates on a particular topic with prepared written arguments.
5. Working in online workshops, forums and blogs.
6. Using Moodle to activate students in an electronic environment.
