- Student discovers policies and complex problem solving issues in small states.

- Ability to place small states issues in the context.
- Ability to critically evaluate complex problems of small states.
- Ability to place in the context governance and policy making issues in small states.
- Ability to understand intercultural environment.

Predvideni študijski rezultati:

Študent:

- Poda multi-disciplinarno opredelitev majhne države;
- Opiše posebnosti družbeno-ekonomskih razmerij v majhnih državah;
- Analizirati učinke velikosti države na javno upravo, politike, gospodarstvo in mednarodne odnose;
- Identificira izzive in priložnosti majhnih držav v EU, ter operacionalizirati pametne strategije;
- Karakterizira posebnosti majhne ekonomije v kontekstu večnivojskih upravljavskih razmerij in globalizacije;
- Reši konkreten problem majhne države ter oblikovati svetovalni predlog za upravljavске strukture majhne države.

Intended learning outcomes:

Students:

- know how small states are defined according to different disciplinary/ theoretical perspectives (international relations, economics, public administration, sociology);
- describe the special characteristics of role-relationships in small societies and their impact on political, administrative and economic behavior;
- analyze the impact of size on small states' politics, public administration, economy and international relations;
- discuss the challenges and opportunities of small states in Europe and their strategies in taking advantage of the EU institutional structures, including the 'smart state strategy';
- characterize the special traits of small markets, relate these to the potential goals and means of economic policy in the context of global markets and multi-level governance.;
- be able to apply the gained knowledge to a practical policy problem in order to provide policy advice to a small state government.
